THE ANNUAL LABOR DAY PARADE MONDAY SEPTEMBER 7, 2015: The ILWU Southern California Pensioners will be providing a "Burrito Bonanza" Breakfast at the **ILWU Memorial Hall, 231 W. "C" Street, Wilmington** from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. **The March to Banning Park will begin at 10:00 a.m. on the corner of "E" Street and Broad Ave in Wilmington.** We encourage all our members and their Families to participate in the march to show our solidarity for all labor. **We need members to hold the banner during the march, Please call the office if you can help.** There will be Music, BBQ and soft drinks available at Banning park following the parade. Please come out and support the Labor movement.

LABOR DAY'S HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: **Monday September 7th** is a **NO** work day (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a **paid holiday**. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you **must** work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, **Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 7th** does not count as one of the days. Flops do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims **must** include **Monday through Friday** of the respective Holiday week and filed with the office prior to the Holiday.

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching **Sunday September 6th** between **4 pm and 4:30 pm** for Sunday night, any work that we may have on **Labor Day** (day or night) **Monday September 7th** (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 8th**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for.

Dispatch Issues: The officers would like to remind you that you must call back for your jobs in a timely manner. The time for the **Night side is between 2 pm and 3 pm** and for the **Day side between 4 pm and 4:30 pm.**



When Lasher's are ordered: a lashing Foremen shall be employed to supervise up to 20 Longshoremen. Port Supplement 10.1421 (**This Rule Applies to Lash Back Only**). When a late order is placed for extra Lasher's which brings the total number of Lasher's above 20 an **additional lashing Foreman must be ordered immediately**. Do Not wait to see if the lashing order is filled. Foremen must be ordered first!!

Overlapping Shifts: As per **Membership Meeting of August 5, 2010**, It was agreed that you must call a replacement immediately upon discovering that you will be working extended and are unable to arrive at the next job in a timely manner. If this action causes you to replace yourself for the 3rd shift, there will be no penalty

Cell Phones and videos: The use of cell phones is a violation of the Pacific Coast Marine Safety Code rule 629. Please remind your workforce how important it is to stay focused and that if they violate this rule they will be fired. Video recording is also not allowed on a job!!

Fines and Assessments: If you receive a fine card please do not ignore it! If you have a question about the fine please call the office. All Steady Foremen working on the night of a meeting receive credit for non-attendance of the meeting but are required to call the office to let us know that you worked. As per Article IX Section 1. (g) All members 15 days delinquent in any fine or assessment shall be cited before the Executive Board. Do not allow this to happen to you.
