Stop Work Membership Meeting Thursday December 7, 2017, 7 pm at the Cruise Terminal S. P. 93

Executive Board: This month's meeting will be Wednesday, November 29, 2017 at 11:30 AM.

Reminder: Friday December 22ND is the last day for the payroll of 2017. *Check your hours!*

Paid Holidays: Christmas Eve **Sunday December 24th**, Christmas Day **Monday December 25th**, New Year's Eve **Sunday December 31th**, and New Year's Day. **Monday January 1st 2017** are paid holidays. To be eligible for holiday pay, you **must** work or be available for work at least **2 days** of the week, **Tuesday thru Friday. Monday and flops do not count as a day of availability.** Vacation claims for the Holiday weeks **must** be **Monday through Friday** of the respective Holiday weeks.

Holiday Dispatch: Dispatch for **Monday December 25th Christmas Day or Night** and **Tuesday December 26th 1st shift** will take place **Sunday December 24th Between 2:00 pm and 2:30 pm**, The office will be closed at **3:00 pm. SHRAP!**

Dispatch for **Monday January 1st New Year's Day or Night** and **Tuesday January 2nd 1st shift** will take place **Sunday December 31st between 2:00 pm and 2:30 pm**, The office will be closed at **3:00 pm.**

Deadline to check-in for Holiday Dispatch for resident Foremen in LA/LB will be 1:00 PM on Sunday December 24th and Sunday December 31st and resident Foremen in San Diego and Port Hueneme it will be 11 AM. SHARP!

Exception: An extended shift may be worked from **3 PM to 5 PM** on **Sunday December 24th and Sunday December 31st** to finish a **ship** or **rail** otherwise all work is to end at **3 PM.**

(This Exception does not apply to yard work).

New Foremen: The second class of 20 began their probationary Foremen training class on November 6, as of Saturday November 18, 2017, they will check-in on the day side as probationary Foremen. Please assist them with some guidance and leadership and remember we were all new at one time. The next class will start Monday December 4, 2017

When Lasher's are ordered: a lashing Foremen shall be employed to supervise up to 20 Longshoremen. Port Supplement 10.1421 (**This Rule Applies to Lash Back Only**). When a late order is placed for extra Lasher's which brings the total number of Lasher's ordered above 20 an **additional lashing Foreman must be ordered immediately**. Do Not wait to see if the lashing order is filled. Foremen must be ordered first!!

Doctor's notes and especially LS 208's for workers compensation claims and non-industrial injuries. This information is needed in case we need to file the proper documentation for vacation, pension, welfare, and holiday claims that you may be entitled to. Please keep any change of address and phone numbers current with the office.

Fines and Assessments: If you receive a card please do not ignore it! If you have a question about the fine please call the office. All Steady Foremen working on the night of a meeting receive credit for non-attendance of the meeting but are required to call the office to let us know that you worked. As per Article IX Section 1.
