**LABOR DAY'S HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE:** *Monday September 4<sup>th</sup>* is a **NO** work day (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a *paid holiday*. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, *Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 4<sup>th</sup>* does **not** count as one of the days of availability. **Flops** do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims **must** include *Monday through Friday* of the respective Holiday week and filed with the office prior to the Holiday in order to be paid for the holiday. Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday.

**HOLIDAY DISPATCH:** We will be dispatching *Sunday September 3<sup>rd</sup>* between **4 pm and 4:30 pm** for any work that is ordered for **Labor Day** (day or night) *Monday September 4<sup>th</sup>* (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for and if you would like to travel.

**ILWU-PMA Benefit Plans:** A notice was mailed to all participants enrolled in the ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan regarding a list of doctors and a facility that will no longer be covered under our welfare plan as of August 17, 2017. Please make sure that you read and understand this notice so that you will not be liable for any services provided by these physicians. If you have any questions, please contact Sam Alvarado.

**Steady Job Postings:** The procedure for applying for a Steady Foremen Employment as outlined in SCWB-0009-2017. The Employer posting for a steady position will describe the criteria for the steady Foremen job. Each applicant for the posting is required to hand-deliver two copies of the completed application to the person designated in the posting. The person designated in the posting to receive the application will initial and date two copies one for the employer and one for the applicant. Every applicant who hands in a completed application during the first 10 calendar days from the date of posting will be offered an interview at a time and location designated by the posting Employer. The posting Employer can fill the job, or decide not to fill the job, any time after 10 calendar days from the date of posting. The Employer will continue to interview applicants until the Employer fills the job or decides not to fill the job, or pulls the posting. The posting Employer will notify each applicant interviewed whether or not they were selected for the job, and will inform applicants who applied for the posted job after the Employer filled the job or decided not to fill the job that they would not be interviewed for that reason. The posting Employer will inform Local 94 promptly upon hiring or deciding not to hire for a posted steady position, so Local 94 can take down the posting and inform members that the posting is no longer open.
