LABOR DAY'S HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: Monday September 4th is a **NO** work day (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a paid holiday. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 5th does **not** count as one of the days of availability. **Flops** do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims **must** include Monday through Friday of the respective Holiday week and filed with the office prior to the Holiday to be paid for the holiday. Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday.

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching Sunday September 3rd between **3:00 pm and 3:30 pm** for Sunday night 2nd & 3rd shifts, and any work that is ordered for **Labor Day** (day or night) Monday September 4th (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 5th**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for and if you would like to travel.

ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan Members: For all members that are enrolled in the California Coastwise Indemnity Plan (CIP), effective September 1, 2017. New identification cards for the BlueCard program will be mailed to you. Each family is being mailed 2 cards. If you need additional information, please call the benefits plan at 415-673-8500

Steady Foremen's Weekly Schedule: All Employers are to provide their Steady Foreman with a weekly five-day schedule no later than 3 pm Friday for the following week's availability as per SCWB-0027-2010. If you're not receiving a schedule from your employer you must demand it, if they fail to comply, please contact the office. All Steadies are responsible for calling their own replacement for any of the days they are scheduled to work. Those replacements are property of the Dispatch Hall. If your employer does not have 5 shifts of work in a payroll week (7 shifts per week) that employer is required to pay the 50-hour minimum guarantee, 10 hours of guarantee for every shift they have no work.

Foreman's Vacations: A steady Foreman can only claim a vacation Monday through Friday with their Steady Employer. Vacation for individuals working out of the hall can be claimed for any 5 consecutive days or nights. When you come back you will check in on average or your hours whichever is higher.
