Foreman's Vacations: A steady Foreman can only claim a vacation Monday through Friday with their Steady Employer. Vacation for individuals working out of the hall can be claimed for any 5 consecutive days or nights. When you come back you will check in on average or your hours whichever is higher.

Going Aloft: when sending swingman aloft it is the duty and responsibility for the Foreman to go aloft with them at all times. Failure to comply will result in you being cited before the Executive board.

Double back: When you choose to work additional shifts, whether you are a day person or a night person, the shift you are working is the shift you are responsible for. Do not ask to be relieved early so that you can get to another job. It is your responsibility at dispatch to decide whether or not to accept that additional shift and if it is going to cause a conflict you must do the right thing.
