Steady Foremen: If you choose to work as a steady Foreman you must follow the agreement as outlined in the PCWB&FA Letter of Understanding (LOU) Walking Bosses/Foremen's Steady Pay Guarantee page 143. Each Employer shall provide its steady Foremen a weekly 5-day work schedule no later than Friday. Steady Foreman who are unable to work any of their scheduled workdays **must** call a replacement through the Joint Foreman's Dispatch Hall and their 50-hour guarantee will be reduced 10 hours for each scheduled day not worked.

If you are working less than five shifts per week for your employer and you haven't called a replacement you must receive your guarantee for those days or you are in violation of the contract, and Membership Action, If you fail to comply with the Steady Foremen Agreement you will be cited to appear before the Executive Board. If you have any questions, please call the office.

Travel: When checking in for travel you must be checked-in as travel all. Please include if you want to double or 3rd shift to a first. Remember to call back for your work assignment by the proper time as not to be late for work and to avoid traffic issues. In most cases a dispatcher will call you so that you will have proper notice to travel to the port assigned. Please be available by phone when Checked-in for travel!!

Union Meetings: It is your right and your obligation to attend our Union meetings. The power of this great Union is with the Rank and File. Your voice can not be heard unless you are there to participate.

Lashing Foremen on a Drop: The office has received numerous calls regarding the number of lashers the employers order on a drop. if in your opinion there are more Lashers than you can safely supervise, inform your Ship Boss that you need additional help. Contact the office if necessary.

Fines and Assessments: If you receive a card please do not ignore it! If you have a question about the fine, please call the office. **All Steady Foremen working on the night of a meeting receive credit for non-attendance of the meeting but are required to call the office to let us know that you worked.** As per Article IX Section 1. (g) All members 15 days' delinquent in any fine or assessment shall be cited before the Executive Board. Do not allow this to happen to you.
