**Payrolls:** It is a vital function of our job as Foremen to see to it that these documents are filled out properly. It is the Ship Bosses responsibility on vessels operations to ensure all Foremen under their supervision plus, Rail and Yard Foremen on their operation, completely and properly fill out the payrolls. If this means that you must hold on to the payrolls until the end of the shift before you turn them in then so be it. Protect our jurisdiction at all times.

Changes in beneficiary designation may be made at any time by submitting a new Beneficiary Designation Form to the Benefit Plans Office. **HOLIDAY PAY:** Independence Day, **Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup>** is a normal work day at the overtime rate of pay and a paid Holiday. **Thursday, July 5<sup>th</sup>** is a no work holiday (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) in honor of Bloody Thursday.
