Re: City of Los Angeles/Port of Los Angeles - Private Road Security Improvements

Please generate a memorandum and communicate to the business officials of the ILWU Local 94/13/63 so they can share with their membership when employed at the Ports America/West Basin Container Terminal.

The City of Los Angeles in conjunction with the Port of Los Angeles have recently completed security improvements at the entrance and exit of the private roadway leading to the ILWU parking area at Berth 121-126. The roadway is 2 lanes, 1 in each direction when entering and exiting this location.

A (Gate Arm) has been installed at the entrance lane and (Ground Spikes) at the exit lane leading out to the public right away. These security improvements are to support access control measures in the wake of the security breach in August 2017.

Motorists should drive with caution and safely when transiting to/from the Ports America/WBCT facility. The ground spikes at the lane exiting the private roadway will be raised for operation on Monday, April 9, 2018.
