Executive Board Meeting: Our next meeting will be Wednesday, September 25 at 11:30 AM.

LABOR DAY HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: Monday September 2nd is a **NO** work day (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a paid holiday. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 2nd does **not** count as one of the days of availability. **Flops** do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims **must** include Monday through Friday of the respective Holiday week and **filed with the office prior to the Holiday to be paid for the holiday. Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday.**

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching Sunday September 1st between **1:00 pm and 2:00 pm** for Sunday night 2nd & 3rd shifts, and any work that is ordered for **Labor Day** (day or night) Monday September 2nd (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 3rd**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for and if you would like to travel.

Dispatch for Travel: For LA/LB members who would like to travel to either Port Hueneme or San Diego you must be checked in as follows. For **Port Hueneme** on **weekends and holidays** you must be **checked in by 9 AM** for work that night or the following day. For work during the week **Monday through Friday** unless there's a holiday you must be checked in by **11 AM** for work that night or the following day. For the **Port of San Diego**, you must be checked in every day by **11 AM** for work that night or the following day. These are the standard check-in times for the two ports. Don't be late.
