## MEMBERSHIP MEETING

**Wednesday, July 3, 2019 7 PM at the Cruise Terminal S.P. 93**

**Executive Board:** This month's meeting will be Wednesday July 26, 2019 at 11:30 AM.

**Harbor Commission Vote:** The Commissioners voted 3 to 2 against the appeal of the land use permit which allows APMT to proceed with their plans to automate pier 400. This issue will move to the LA City Counsel for further review.

**HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE:** Independence Day, **Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>** is a normal work day at the overtime rate of pay and a paid Holiday. **Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup>** is a no work holiday (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) in honor of Bloody Thursday.

**HOLIDAY DISPATCH:** We will be dispatching **Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>** for any work that we may have for **Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup>** (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables) and **Dayside Saturday, July 6<sup>th</sup>**. **You must be checked in by 12 Noon July 4<sup>th</sup> and call back between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. for your July 4<sup>th</sup> Night Side, July 5<sup>th</sup> Day and Night Side and Day Side July 6<sup>th</sup> jobs. Please when checking in on the phone, be clear on what shift you are checking in for.**

**Foreman's Vacations:** A steady Foreman can only claim a vacation Monday through Friday with their Steady Employer. Vacation for individuals working out of the hall can be claimed for any 5 consecutive days or nights. When you come back you will check in on average or your hours whichever is higher.

**Wage Increase:** Beginning Saturday, June 29, 2019 our basic wage will increase as outlined in Section 4.11 of the PCWB&FA.

**Early Retirement Window:** To be eligible you must submit an application, have a minimum of 13 qualifying years of service and be 59 ½ years old Between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2022. Qualified individuals will receive unreduced benefits under the ILWU-PMA Pension Plan.

**Hiring Process:** On Saturday, June 22, 2019 inside the tent at SP 92 for the individuals that arrived on time, the written test was administered. Biddle consulting group will tabulate the scores and we should be ready to start the interviews in the later part of July.

**Steady Job Postings:** The procedure for applying for a Steady Foremen Employment as outlined in SCWB-0009-2017. The Employer posting for a steady position will describe the criteria for the steady Foremen job. Each applicant for the posting is required to hand-deliver two copies of the completed application to the person designated in the posting. The person designated in the posting to receive the application will initial and date two copies one for the employer and one for the applicant. Every applicant who hands in a completed application during the first 10 calendar days from the date of posting will be offered an interview at a time and location designated by the posting Employer. The posting Employer can fill the job, or decide not to fill the job, any time after 10 calendar days from the date of posting. The Employer will continue to interview applicants until the Employer fills the job or decides not to fill the job or pulls the posting. The posting Employer will notify each applicant interviewed whether they were selected for the job and will inform applicants who applied for the posted job after the Employer filled the job or decided not to fill the job that they would not be interviewed for that reason. The posting Employer will inform Local 94 promptly upon hiring or deciding not to hire for a posted steady position, so Local 94 can take down the posting and inform members that the posting is no longer open.
