Foreman's Responsibilities: It is the duty of a Foreman to verify that the cargo you are handling is safe to load and or discharge. This includes the verification that cones are either locked or unlocked, Lids are either dogged or un-dogged, and all gear stowed correctly.

On Time: It is important for all foremen to set an exemplary standard. Being on time is a character trait that most people find important. Please show respect to yourself and your Brothers and Sisters by being on time and ready to go to work.

Steady Foremen: If you choose to work as a steady Foreman you must follow the agreement as outlined in the PCWB&FA Letter of Understanding (LOU) Walking Bosses/Foremen's Steady Pay Guarantee page 143 and SCWB-0027-2010. Each Employer shall provide its steady Foremen a weekly 5-day work schedule no later than Friday. Steady Foreman who are unable to work any of their scheduled workdays **must** call a replacement through the Joint Foreman's Dispatch Hall and their 50-hour guarantee will be reduced 10 hours for each scheduled day not worked. If you are working less than five shifts per week for your employer and you haven't called a replacement you must receive your guarantee for those days or you are in violation of the contract, and Membership Action, and you will be cited to appear before the Executive Board. If you have any questions, please call the office.

Hiring Process: For the 444 individuals that will be moving forward in the process, the written test will take place on Saturday, June 22, 2019 inside the tent at SP 92.

Travel: When checking in for travel you must be checked-in as travel all. Please include if you want to double or 3rd shift to a first. Remember to call back for your work assignment by the proper time as not to be late for work and to avoid traffic issues. In most cases a dispatcher will call you so that you will have proper notice to travel to the port assigned. Please be available by phone when Checked-in for travel!!

Going Aloft: when sending swingman aloft it is the duty and responsibility for the Foreman to go aloft with them at all times. Failure to comply will result in you being cited before the Executive board.

Fines and Assessments: If you receive a card please do not ignore it! If you have a question about the fine, please call the office. **All Steady Foremen working on the night of a meeting receive credit for non-attendance of the meeting but are required to call the office to let us know that you worked.** As per Article IX Section 1. (g) All members 15 days' delinquent in any fine or assessment shall be cited before the Executive Board. Do not allow this to happen to you. **Please contact the office to find out how much you owe and submit your check immediately to ILWU Local 94 @ 411 N. Harbor Blvd. Suite 303 San Pedro, CA 90731.**
