Adhering to the Local, State and Federal restricted gathering guidelines, our Membership Meetings will be postponed until further notice

Executive Board: This month's meeting will be by a phone conference call on Wednesday, February 25, 2020 at 11:30 AM. Executive Board members will be provided a call-in number.

Coronavirus: Information is available on our website WWW> ILWULOCAL94.ORG and will be updated as information becomes available. Please make yourself aware of the recommended safety precautions i.e. handwashing for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer, eye protection, mask, cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing, and social distancing. When possible divide and separate your labor into smaller groups to provide them their safety talks and job-related information. **If you feel sick, please stay at home.**

PGP: if you qualify for PGP which is \$2,459.60 per week you will receive a letter in the mail that will explain the steps that must be taken for you to receive this benefit. You will need to fill out part of that form and either call the unemployment office or visit them personally to complete the application. Section 6 of the PCWB&FA explains in more detail. If your weekly gross income is below \$2,459.60 you will receive the difference in your paycheck in the week following your normal pay date. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

Travel: The Coast parties agreed there will be no voluntary travel between ports through April 16, 2020.

If you are interested in signing up to become a temporary residence Foreman in either Port Hueneme or San Diego please contact the office. Some of the restrictions would require you to work only out of those specific ports without the ability to travel back and work in LA/LB for a designated period of time.

As per membership action: At the membership meeting on March 4, 2022 two motions were passed. #1) M/S/C/U Steady Foreman are to work only their five scheduled days of the original schedule that is sent to the Joint Dispatch hall by their employer on Friday by 3:00 pm. If the steady Foreman cannot work one of their scheduled shifts, they must call replacement to the



Dispatch hall. If they wish to work an additional day other than their originally scheduled five days, they must volunteer through the Dispatch hall. To be reviewed monthly. #2 M/S/C/U All jobs dispatched through the Joint Dispatch hall are one shift only, no comebacks. To be reviewed monthly. All steady Foreman are required to receive their 5-day schedule from their steady employer by 3:00 pm on Fridays. No revisions will be accepted after this 3:00 pm Friday deadline. If you do not receive your schedule, call the office.

Paid Holidays: Caesar Chavez' Birthday Tuesday March 31 is a normal workday, paid at the overtime rate of pay.
