Since Independence Day falls on a Sunday, July 4th, Section 5.21 States that the Holiday will be observed on Monday, July 5th at the overtime rate of pay. **Friday, July 5th** is a ***no work holiday*** (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) in honor of Bloody Thursday.
