MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Executive Board: This month's meeting will be Wednesday, August 31, 2022.

LABOR DAY HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: Monday September 5th is a **NO** workday (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a paid holiday. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, **Tuesday through Friday**. Monday September 5th does **not** count as one of the days of availability. **Flops** do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims **must** include **Monday through Friday** of the respective Holiday week and **filed with the office prior to the Holiday**. **Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday**.

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching Sunday September 4th between **1:00 pm and 2:00 pm** for **Sunday night 2nd & 3rd shifts**, any work that is ordered for **Labor Day** (day or night) **Monday September 5th** (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for **Dayside Tuesday, September 6th**. Please when checking in be clear on what shift you are checking in for.

Steady Applications: Go to our website www.ilwulocal94.org and download the application for the company you wish to apply for. Follow the directions carefully and contact Vice President Duane Martinez once you have filled in the required information. Your application will be submitted by Duane on your behalf via email. **No applications will be physically submitted, and interviews will be conducted over the phone only. Applications that are submitted in person will be invalid.**

Travel: If you want to travel you must be checked in by 9:00 am for that night and the following day's dispatch. If you are leaving a message on the tape, please be clear on what shift you are checking in for. **Travel is only allowed to cover key jobs.**

Lashing: If you are on a drop with more than 30 lashers you need to request an additional Foremen to help safely supervise your labor. If you need help, contact the office.

Replacements: If you need to call a replacement, it is your responsibility to call the dispatch hall and speak to an officer to be replaced. It is also your responsibility to stay on the job and protect your job until a replacement shows or an elevation is in place to cover the job. Failure to comply with any of these procedures will result in you being cited to the Executive Board for abandoning your job.

Union Meeting: Constitution By-Laws General Rules item #2 page 26, All active members are required to attend at least one (1) meeting every two (2) months or be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00). This rule does not apply to members who are sick, injured or working. No member can be excused from meetings two (2) consecutive months for any reason, except as stated above, or is on vacation. Any active member missing three (3) consecutive meetings shall be cited before the Executive Board.

It is your sworn duty and obligation to attend your Union meetings.

Fines and Assessments: Constitution By-Laws General Rules Article IX Section 1 (g) page 14, All members fifteen (15) days delinquent in any fine or assessment, shall be cited before the Executive Board.

It is also your duty and obligation to make every effort to pay your fines and assessments in a timely manner.

Checking in: If you are working a day shift and are looking to check-in or volunteer for a night shift, please inform the dispatchers where you are working.
