MEMBERSHIP MEETING


Wednesday September 6, 2023, 6:30 PM at the Cruise Terminal S.P. 93.

Executive Board: This month's meeting will be Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 11:30 AM.

LABOR DAY HOLIDAY PAY SCHEDULE: Monday September 4th is a NO workday (except for rails, military, passenger, or perishables) and a paid holiday. To be eligible for Labor Day holiday pay, you must work or be available for work at least 2 days of the week, Tuesday through Friday. Monday September 4th does not count as one of the days of availability. Flops do not count as a day of availability. Vacation claims must include Monday through Friday of the respective Holiday week and filed with the office prior to the Holiday. Late filing will result in nonpayment of the holiday.

HOLIDAY DISPATCH: We will be dispatching Sunday September 3rd between 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm for Sunday night 2nd & 3rd shifts, any work that is ordered for Labor Day (day or night) Monday September 4th (Rails, Military, Passenger, or Perishables only) and for Dayside Tuesday, September 5th. You must be checked in by 12 noon and be clear on what shift you are checking in for.

Vertical Tandem Lifts: It is required that you notify an officer before discharging or loading a vertical tandem lift. All options must be discussed, and management needs to be notified prior to discharging or loading vertical tandem lifts. Failure to comply will result in you being cited to appear before the Executive Board.

Lashing: If you are on a drop with more than 30 lashers you need to request an additional Foreman to help safely supervise your labor. If you need help, contact the office.

Steady Applications: Go to our website www.ilwulocal94.org and download the application for the company you wish to apply for. Follow the directions carefully and contact Vice President Duane Martinez once you have filled in the required information. Your application will be submitted by Duane on your behalf via email. **No applications will be physically submitted, and interviews will be conducted over the phone only. Applications that are submitted in person will be invalid.**

Going Steady: If you are going to be hired as a steady you must be checked in for that shift and receive your initial dispatch from the Joint Foremen's dispatch hall.

Reminder Check in Times: In LA/LB you must be checked in by 3:30 pm for work on the dayside and 1:00 pm for work on the nightside. In Port Hueneme you must be checked by 11:00 am Monday through Friday and 9:00 am on the Weekends and Holidays. In San Diego you must be checked in by 11:00 am every day. If you want to travel all Local 94 Members must be checked in by 9:00 am for the nightside and the following dayside.

FINES AND ASSESSMENTS: Per Constitution By-Laws General Rules Article IX Section 1(g), "All members fifteen (15) days delinquent in any fine or assessment, shall be cited before the Executive Board." It is also your duty and obligation to make every effort to pay your fines and assessments in a timely manner.

As per Membership action of the September 7, 2022: Members are not allowed to double up or double back until all fines are paid.
