STEADY WORK OPPORTUNITIES BULLETIN

February 17, 2010

As you know, Local 94 received an adverse arbitrator's ruling in our dispute with PMA regarding the guaranteed pay for steady foremen. We are moving to vacate that ruling in federal court, and will keep you informed of developments. We are also responding to a subsequent ruling finding that Local 94 and its officers are guilty of concerted action regarding the resignations of steady foremen on May 2, 2009. That ruling says that the "officers and members of Local 94 shall fill steady positions as per past practice immediately."

To comply with this Order we are doing everything we can to fill steady positions as per past practice. Specifically, when employers advertize openings for steady positions, those openings are posted in the Local office for 60 days or until the position is filled. Also, openings for steady positions are announced daily on the Local's steady work opportunities voice mail system, 310-832-1864.

Local 94 members are encouraged to apply for steady positions. Local 94 members do not need to seek approval from Local 94 officers to apply for a steady position. Local 94 members are free to decide for themselves whether to apply for a steady position, or whether to remain in a steady position. Local 94 and its officers will take no adverse or beneficial action towards a member based on his or her decision to apply or not apply for a steady position.

To ensure that Local 94 and its officers are in compliance with the Arbitrator's Order quoted above, we are posting this Bulletin in the Local 94 office, mailing it to all Local 94 members, and posting it on the Local 94 website, www.ilwulocal94.org (Bulletin pulldown tab).
